Elizabeth East Kindergarten Sun smart / Hot Weather Policy

In line with DECS policies - Elizabeth East Kindergarten is committed in providing and maintaining a safe and healthy working and learning environment for staff, children and visitors to the pre-school. To achieve these aims the pre-school has developed these guidelines regarding sun smart practices for hot weather when working outside.

The children will not be allowed to play outside without hats on days where the UV rating is over 3 (legionnaire or wide brimmed style) they also must wear appropriate clothing (no sleeveless tops).

The parents are responsible for applying sunscreen on children for mornings or afternoon sessions

Children who stay for the whole day (morning, lunch time and afternoon sessions) need to reapply sunscreen during lunchtime (*only during term 1 and 4*). The kindergarten staff will supervise the children while the children apply their sunscreen.

The sunscreen will be provided by the kindergarten, however parents can provide their own e.g. in case of allergy.
